Directions: Create an informational book about the governments and economic systems of India, Japan, China, and North Korea. Use the CIA World Factbook to find the information needed to create your book.

Each page must include the following:

1. Name of Country, capital city
2. Government type (what it is + definition)
 - Executive title(s)
 - Legislative title (unicameral or bicameral?)
3. How the government distributes power: federal or unitary (word + definition).
4. How the government determines citizen participation: autocracy, oligarchy, Parliamentary democracy, Presidential democracy (word + definition)
5. How do citizens elect their officials? (Suffrage)
6. What type of economic system the country has: traditional, market, command, mixed (what it is called+definition)
7. Type of currency and the symbol
8. GDP real growth rate, country comparison rank
9. Labor force by occupation: agriculture, industry, services
10. Exports/Imports: (commodities) Three of each
11. Drawing of the countries flag (must be in color)

The book must have a cover page with your names, a title for the book.
